




Another step along the project

In the previous newsletter we anticipated that we were ready with the questionnaire to collect data to produce, as a first milestone, a research on a new professional: the personal facilitator, a high skilled person who, inside private companies and public bodies, empowering and working on his/her basic and transversal skills can help both working people and companies to reach two strategic results: improving the quality of working environment and the quality of services and improving the quality of workers lives, above all women in their reconciliation of work and family lives.



All the questionnaires in Italy, Czech Republic and Lithuania have been submitted, all the answers collected and now we are working on cross and numbers.

The second transnational meeting

To share and compare the obtained results, the 21st and 22nd September the partnership had its second transnational meeting, in Torino - Italy.

The Italian partner Bluebook LTD hosted the Czech partner Proeduca and the Lithuanian Partner Panevezys Labour Center in via Magenta c/o Regione Piemonte in order to meet also regional staff involved in funding project with equal opportunity issues.

In fact the partnership during the meeting involved Regione Piemonte, represented by Gian Piera Lisa (Department of equal opportunities of Regione Piemonte)

Gianpiera Lisa presented Piedmont Region gender policies framework and funded projects within 2001-2016 with a focus on work and life balance.

In addition Bluebook involved also Roberta Richiero, project manager of Engim Piemonte (a VET provider) and its director Marco Muzzarelli. Engim representatives presented their courses, delivery modes, methods of financing and the prospects for the future: future courses and new professionals. Of course this was an opportunity to network.
