Background

ProEduca z.s. is a small private association of professional teachers providing supporting services, (mainly trainings for education staff and youth) to schools and non-profit organizations in education. ProEduca has worked in 16 different projects aimed at improvement of the educational system during the last 10 years. These projects were aimed at various issues in education such as curricula modification and development of new training programs for specific target groups (senior learners, unemployed people, teachers, employers, young people etc.). The experts associated in ProEduca have long expertise also in providing the counselling and training services for the clients of the local labour office (preparation for work, counselling job placements, training of the basic skills necessary for the labour market). ProEduca cooperates with several schools of all levels, including universities. ProEduca has experience, professional team, methodology and overall professional capacity needed for the work within Erasmus+ projects. Also, ProEduca has experience in coordination of the international project teams.

Activities and Experience

ProEduca has long experience with the design and development of educational services, including curricula, training programs and learning materials. The association has coordinated or has been involved in many projects dealing with the competency development; competency of the learners (students of the VET schools, adults, etc.) and competency of the training and teaching staff of the education providers, both on national and European levels. Our professional teams have broad experience with work in various research teams aimed at development of the capacity and competency of all three major players on the labour market: employers, employees and training providers.

From among the most significant projects we can mention:

- development of Policy recommendation for the partner countries on role and importance of creativity and creative teaching in the education already on the elementary and secondary levels;
- design of the training program for VET school leavers on development of Entrepreneurship as one of the crucial transversal skills of young employees;
- development of the training program for micro-enterprisers aimed at e-commerce;
- development of a unique methodology of training for seniors based on the Walk and Talk method.

During the project work the professionals involved have gained valuable experience that is being further developed and exploited in the running projects and especially in training courses, where we mostly exploit and spread our own know-how and experience. Most of our courses are provided for foreign participants within the KA1 Erasmus+ projects. Starting from 2018 we provide series of courses aimed at career guidance under the licensed Finnish methodology TOWARDS SUCCESSFUL SENIORITY. The courses are aimed at two different target groups: school staff and young people.

Skills of the staff

The association members are enthusiastic teachers and trainers with professional expertise in teaching and training on all levels of education. The key staff dealing with the Erasmus+ projects are:

Lucie Brzakova works as a director of association, project coordinator and manager. Graduated from Technical University Zvolen, Slovakia, in 1993 and Technical University Ostrava, Czech Republic in 1995. She has been working in the field of education and project management since 1997 and has coordinated a large number of educational projects in the field of education, human resources development, quality management and social services. Every year she takes part at various conferences with the professional papers on the development of the educational system in the country and in EU. In 2017 Lucie completed a course for Auditors of the Age management, and in 2018 a course for facilitators "Towards Successful Seniority™". Speaks fluent English.
