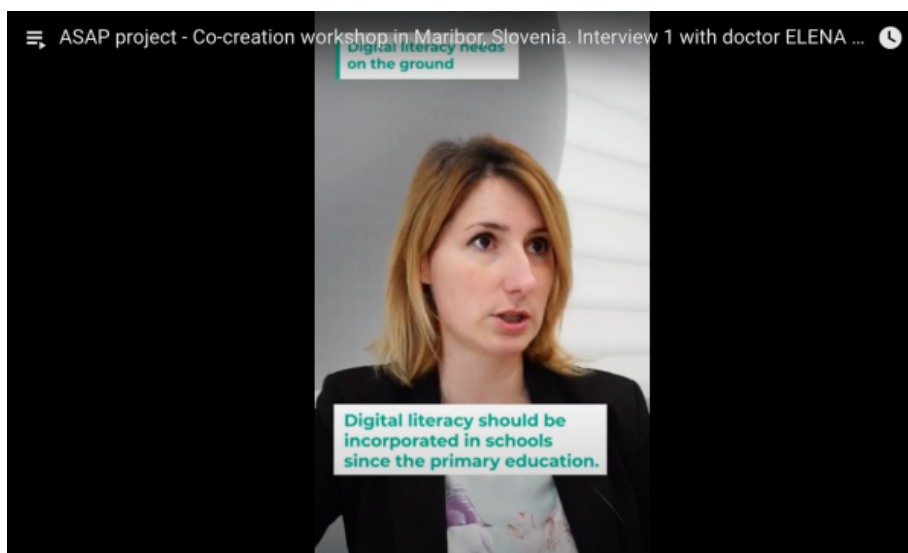
First ASAP co-creation workshop in Maribor, Slovenia

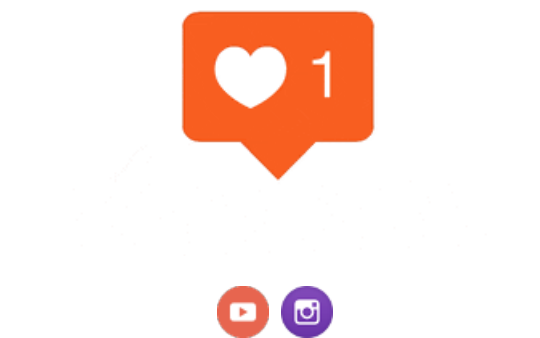
